



I am on Strensiq™ (asfotase alfa), an enzyme replacement therapy to treat HPP.

Interference with clinical laboratory tests is not an uncommon phenomenon. It is theoretically possible that asfotase alfa, a recombinant TNSALP enzyme, may interfere with some lab test platforms such as ELISA (enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay) based tests.

ELISA is a type of blood test platform that may utilize an alkaline-phosphatase enzyme conjugate in the detection system. Depending on the design of the ELISA test, it is possible that the presence of asfotase alfa may result in a laboratory value being falsely low for some tests while falsely high for some others.
